US Figure Skating rules for non-qualifying competitions, as set forth in the 2009-2010 US Figure Skating Rulebook, shall apply. The new **IJS judging system will be used for all short programs & Juvenile through Senior freestyle** all other events will be judged using the 6.0 judging system.

ELIGIBILITY

The 31st Biennial Niagara Invitational Competition is open to all eligible skaters who are members in good standing with US Figure Skating or with Skate Canada. Categories determined by age and/or test passed as of **February 26th, 2010**. Large events will be separated into flights with separate awards for each flight. Skaters may choose to skate in any category for which they qualify. Skaters may not compete below their test level.

ENTRIES

Entries must be filled out completely and legibly to be accepted and postmarked no later than **February 26th, 2010**. The competition chairperson reserves the right to cancel an event if there are less than 3 entrants (with full refund of entry fee), and to combine and divide groups.

ENTRY FEES

All entry fees must accompany application and be made out to: **The Buffalo Skating Club**. All checks and/or money orders must be in US FUNDS ONLY. Late applications are subject to a \$25.00 late fee and will only be accepted upon available time and space. No refunds will be issued after the close of entries (including medical) unless an event has been cancelled (Per Rule CR33.05). Returned checks are subject to a \$25.00 service fee. Entry fees are as follows:

\$60.00 for first event (Freestyle will be considered 1st event)
\$20.00 for 2nd event
\$15.00 for additional events
\$12.00 (per skater) for Team events
\$75.00 (plus \$8.00 per skater listed) for Synchronized events

REGISTRATION

A registration desk will be open throughout the competition, located on the second floor of the Buffalo State College Sports Arena. Competitors should arrive approximately one hour prior to their designated skate time and register promptly upon arrival. Events will not be delayed for late arriving skaters.

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT SHEET

All skaters competing in the short program and Juvenile through Senior freestyle events must fill out a Planned Program Content sheet. These must be returned with the entry form no later than: February 26th, 2010. Entries received without the Planned Program Content sheet will be considered incomplete & will not be processed. Skaters may also update their Planned Program Content on the US Figure Skating website, if doing so please make note of that on your entry form.

AWARDS

Medals will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th and 5th places (all basic skills entrants will receive a ribbon). A club trophy will be awarded to the club accruing the most competition points for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place (excluding Showcase). The Buffalo Skating will not vie for the club trophy.

RESULTS

Results will be available at the registration desk after each event for \$0.25 per copy.

MUSIC

Each competitor must supply their own music on CD's for the freestyle, short program, footwork, showcase and synchronized events. CD's should be clearly labeled with skater's name, event and running time. CD's must have only 1 track. Skaters are urged to bring an additional copy of their competition music. Music is to be turned in at registration and will be available at the registration desk for pick up shortly after the event. The music for the solo dance events will be supplied by the competition committee.

FACILITIES

All events will take place at the Buffalo State College Sports Arena, 1300 Elmwood Avenue, Buffalo, NY 14222. The ice surface is 200' x 85' with rounded corners. The full surface will be used for all events with the exception of the specific compulsory & basic skills events mentioned in this announcement. A snack bar and dressing rooms are available. Various vendors will be on hand selling dresses, t-shirts, pictures, videos and more.

COMPULSORY SPINS

This event will be skated in the form of a free skating program, but without music, with the spins specified for their appropriate level. Connecting moves are permitted between each spin. Spins may be done in any order. There will be deductions for any jumps. Beginner through Pre-Juvenile will be skated on half ice surface. Juvenile and higher will be skated on full ice. Skaters may skate at their test level or one level up.

Intermediate	1 minute 30 seconds max	1. Sit change sit spin (4 revs each foot) 2. Flying camel spin (5 revs) 3. Spin combination with 1 change of position and 1 change of foot (4 revs each foot)
Novice	1 minute 30 seconds max	1. Choice of camel, sit or layback spin (6 revs) 2. Camel to back camel spin (4 revs each foot) 3. Spin combination with 1 change of position and 1 change of foot (5 revs each foot)
Junior / Senior	1 minute 30 seconds max	1. Flying sit spin or flying change (reverse) sit spin (6 revs) 2. Layback or cross foot spin (6 revs) 3. Spin combination with 3 positions and 1 change of foot (5 revs each foot)

JUMP EVENT

Skaters may not skate below their freestyle test level; however they may skate at their freestyle level or one higher. Beginner through Pre-Juvenile level skaters will use only one half of the ice surface. Skaters will not need a program. Required jumps must be performed in the order listed below. Each skater will be given two chances to skate each element (repeated immediately after the first attempt) and will be judged on the better of the two. An Axel will be considered a single jump. When skaters are given a choice of jumps, the first jump (or jump combination) attempted will determine the jump(s) to be judged, and they may not change the jump (or combination) for their second attempt.

COMPULSORY MOVES

This event will be skated in the form of a free skating program, but without music; qualifications are the same as for the free skating events. The required elements may be skated in any order. UNSPECIFIED OR ADDITIONAL MOVES ARE NOT PERMITTED. Marks will be deducted if any are included. Connecting steps are allowed, but such steps should be limited to the minimum necessary to link the various moves. FAILED MANEUVERS ARE NOT TO BE RE-SKATED.

FOOTWORK

Skaters perform footwork sequences of their own design to music of their choice. The program should contain a variety of turns and sequences that emphasize the skater's controlled edges and turns in addition to speed and quickness of the routine. The program may contain one-half rotation jumps and spins with fewer than three revolutions. The routine will be judged on both technical merit and presentation.

SHOWCASE – SOLO & TEAM EVENTS

This is a program with the emphasis on the entertainment value, rather than technical content. Elements to be considered in judging will be illustration of character, music interpretation, costuming (no feathers, dangling beads or other materials that may come off a costume during the performance), and audience appeal. However, skating must be the MAJOR element of the performance and of sufficient competence to support the components chosen. Vocal music is allowed. For this event, skaters must skate at their free skating test level unless otherwise noted. Props are optional. Skaters must carry their own props on and off the ice. For this event, male skaters may be placed in with female skaters depending on number of entries.

TEAM COMPULSORY MOVES

Teams may have 3 to 5 members. No skater can do more than 2 moves. Skaters up to and including Juvenile/Jr. Bronze should be prepared to use one-half the ice surface, if necessary. A separate application and check must be sent for each team. The form must be completely filled out or it will not be accepted. Technical merit only will be judged. Skaters can skate at their test level or one level up.

SYNCHRONIZED SKATING EVENTS

Crossovers are allowed between two levels, providing all requirements are met as defined in the 2009-2010 US Figure Skating Rule Book. Awards will be presented to each skater on teams placing first through third in each division.

Open Juvenile	A team of 8 to 12 skaters. The majority of the team must be 18 years of age or younger by July 1 st , 2009	2:30 minutes
Open Junior	A team of 12 to 20 skaters. Skaters must be at least 12 years of age by July 1 st , 2009. With the majority of skaters 18 years of age or younger.	4:00 minutes
Open Collegiate	A team of 8 to 16 skaters. Skaters must be enrolled in a college or degree program as either part-time or full time students.	3:00 minutes
